

## Paper Decals

You can buy decals/stickers to decorate the outside of your windows with. Or you can make your own! There are all kinds of decals you can make.

Stained Glass Decals need:

- Black paper or paper coloured
- Coloured tissue paper
- Scissors
- \*Scalpel/box cutter  
With adult supervision
- Glue
- Modge podge (optional)
- Tape

Using the samples below or your own design cut out the black shape of the picture. This will be your frame.

\*\*Ask for help from an adult for this step. Carefully cut out shapes of the holes in your black frame using the scalpel or box cutter.

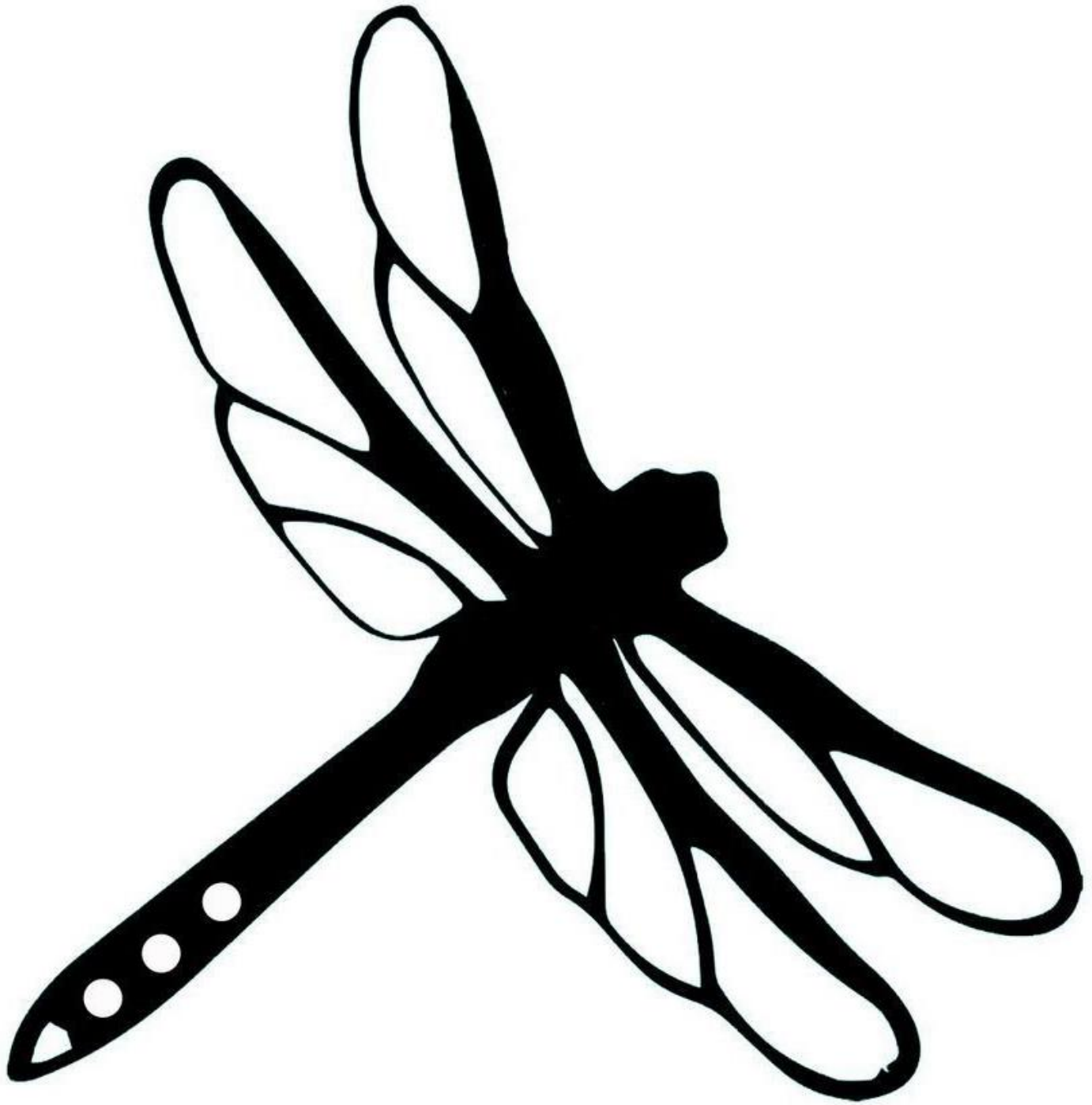


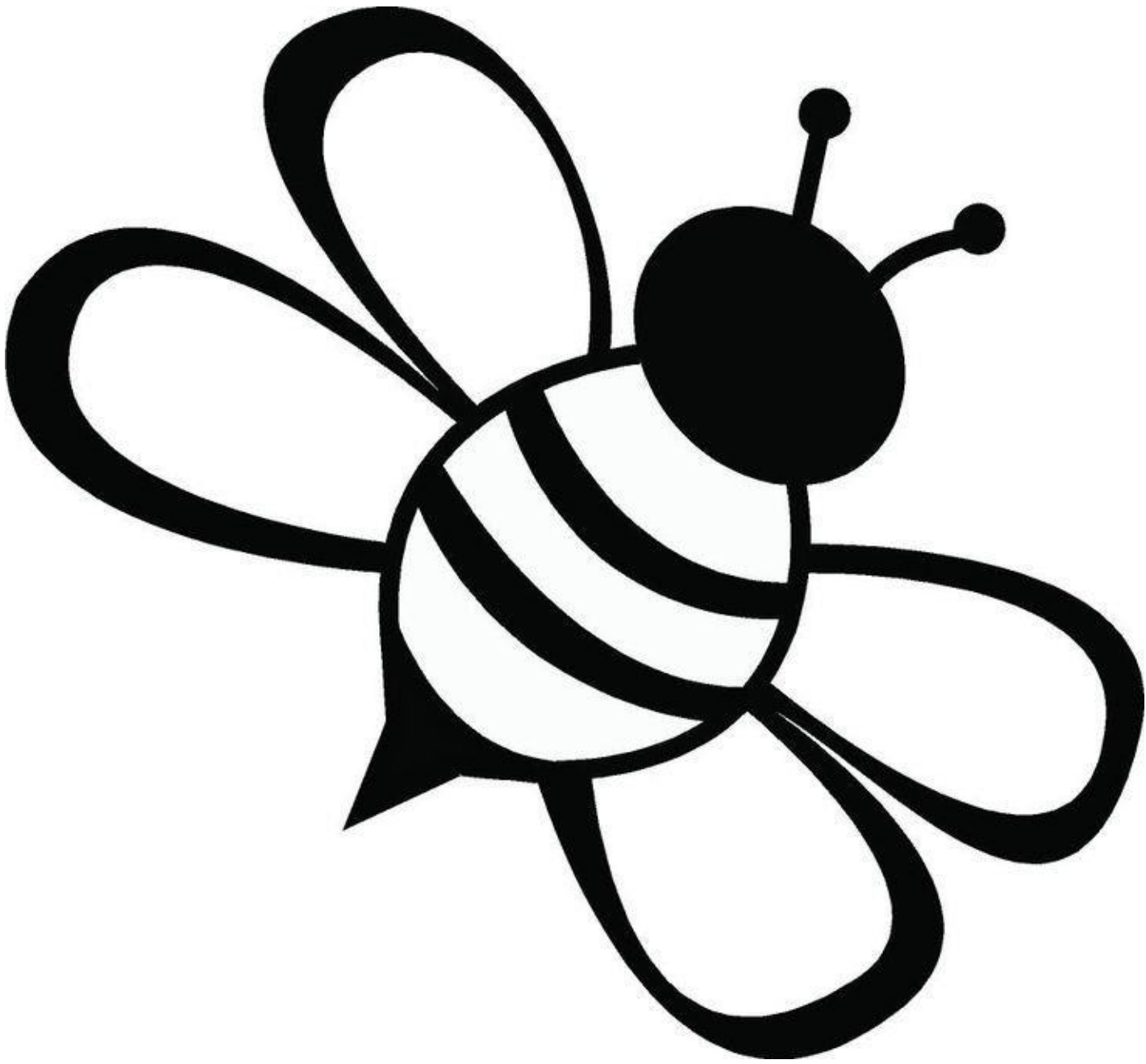
Or you can try to use scissors, but be careful.

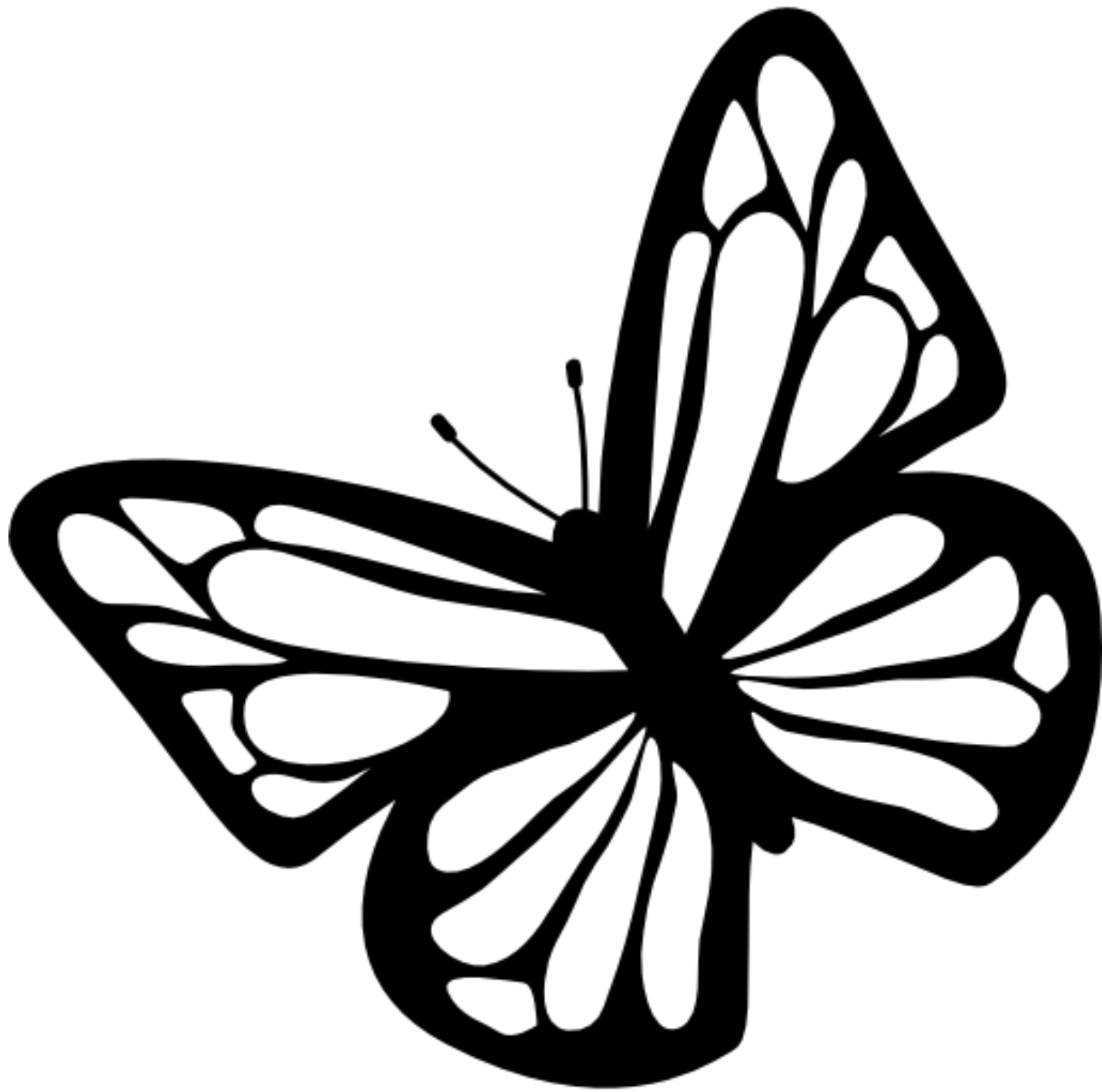
Now cut out pieces of the tissue paper and glue them to one side of the frame, making sure to cover up the entire space you want as that colour. Repeat this until all the holes are covered up.

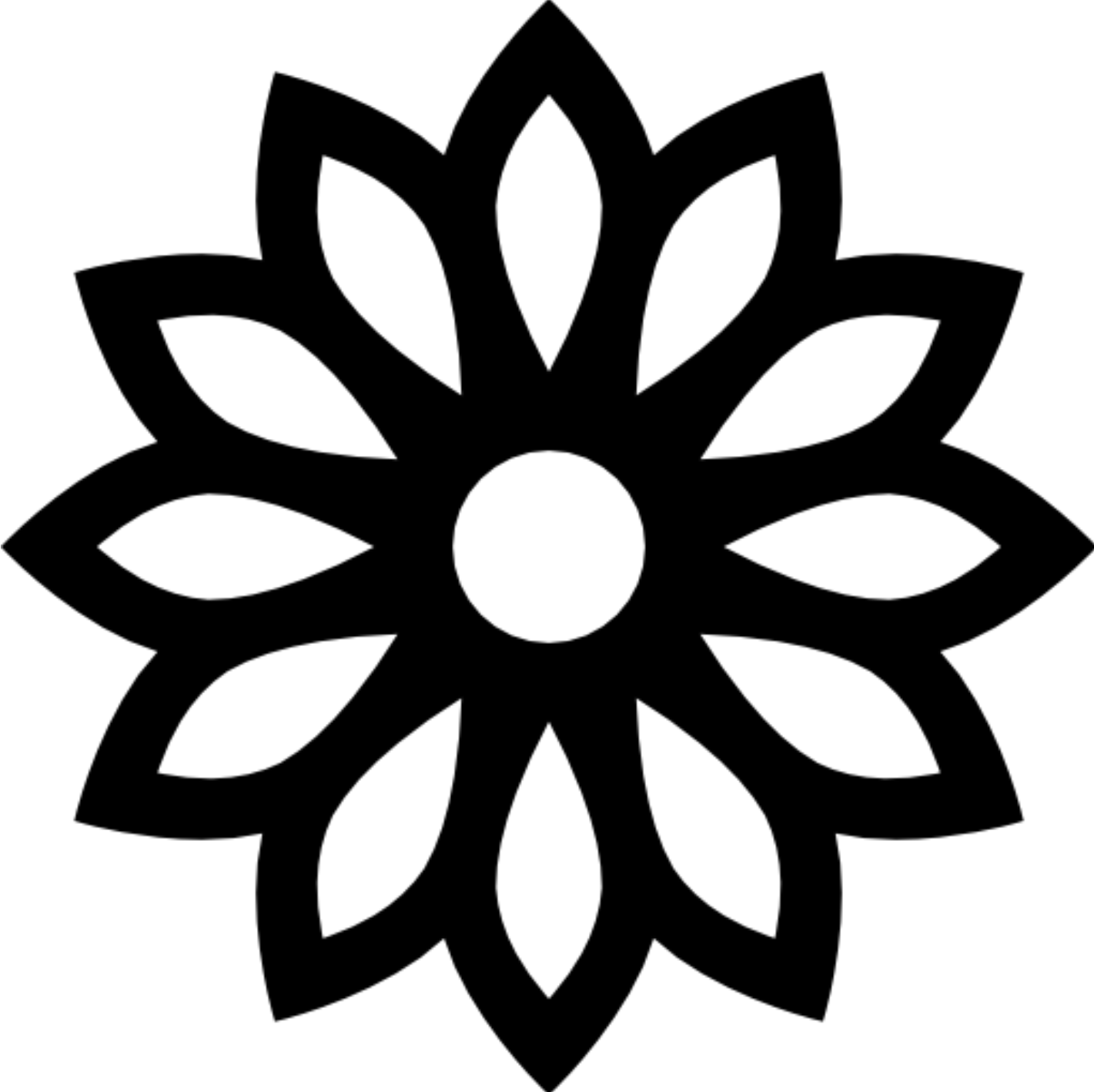
Then when you flip it over, boom! An awesome window decal masterpiece! Now to make it more weather resistant go over one side of the decal with Modge Podge and wait for it to dry. Then repeat on the other side.

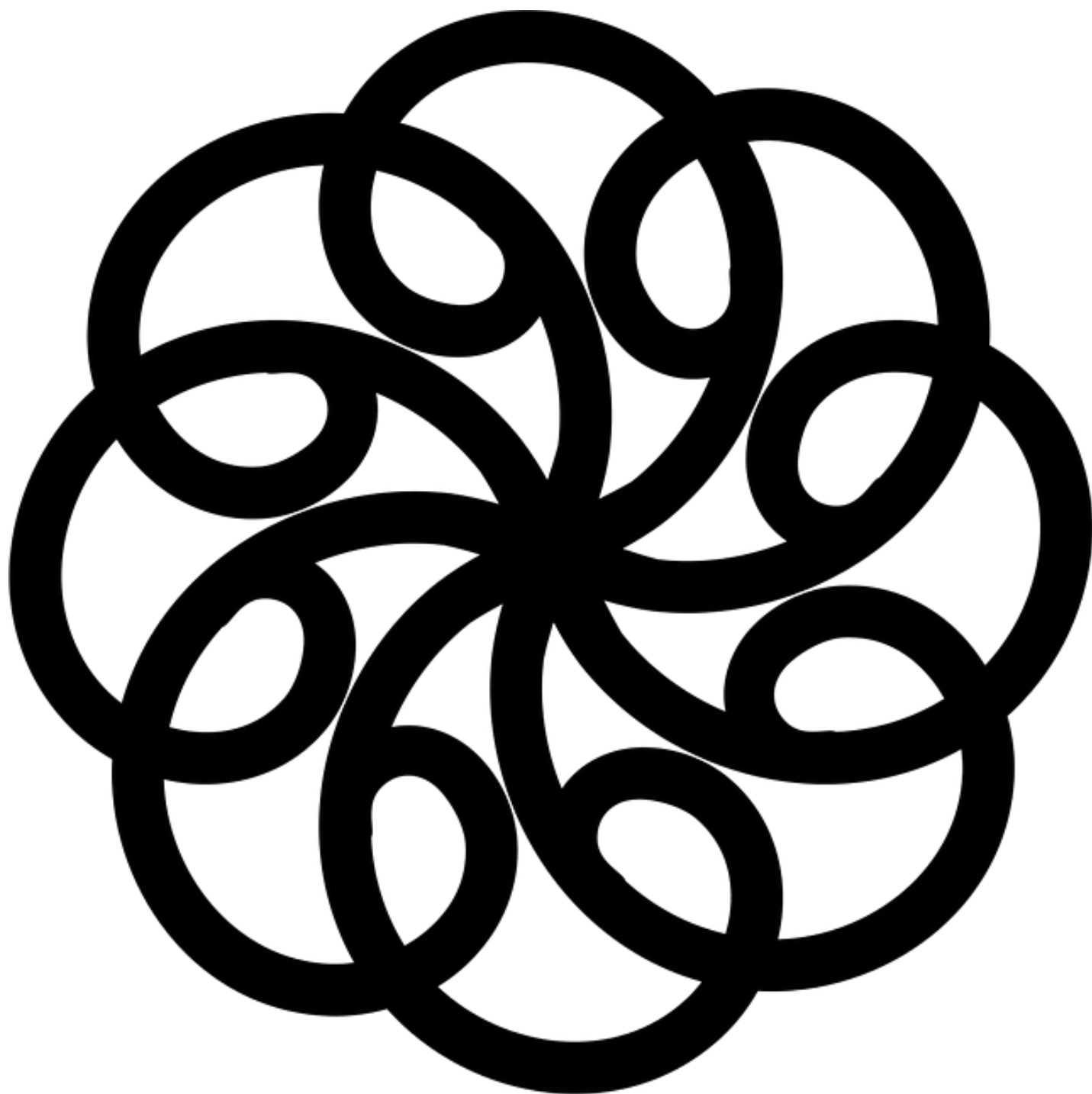
Congratulations you've now created your own window decal! All that's left to do is to tape it up and show the world. When you do tape up the decals make sure to space them at least 5-10cm or 2-4inches apart.

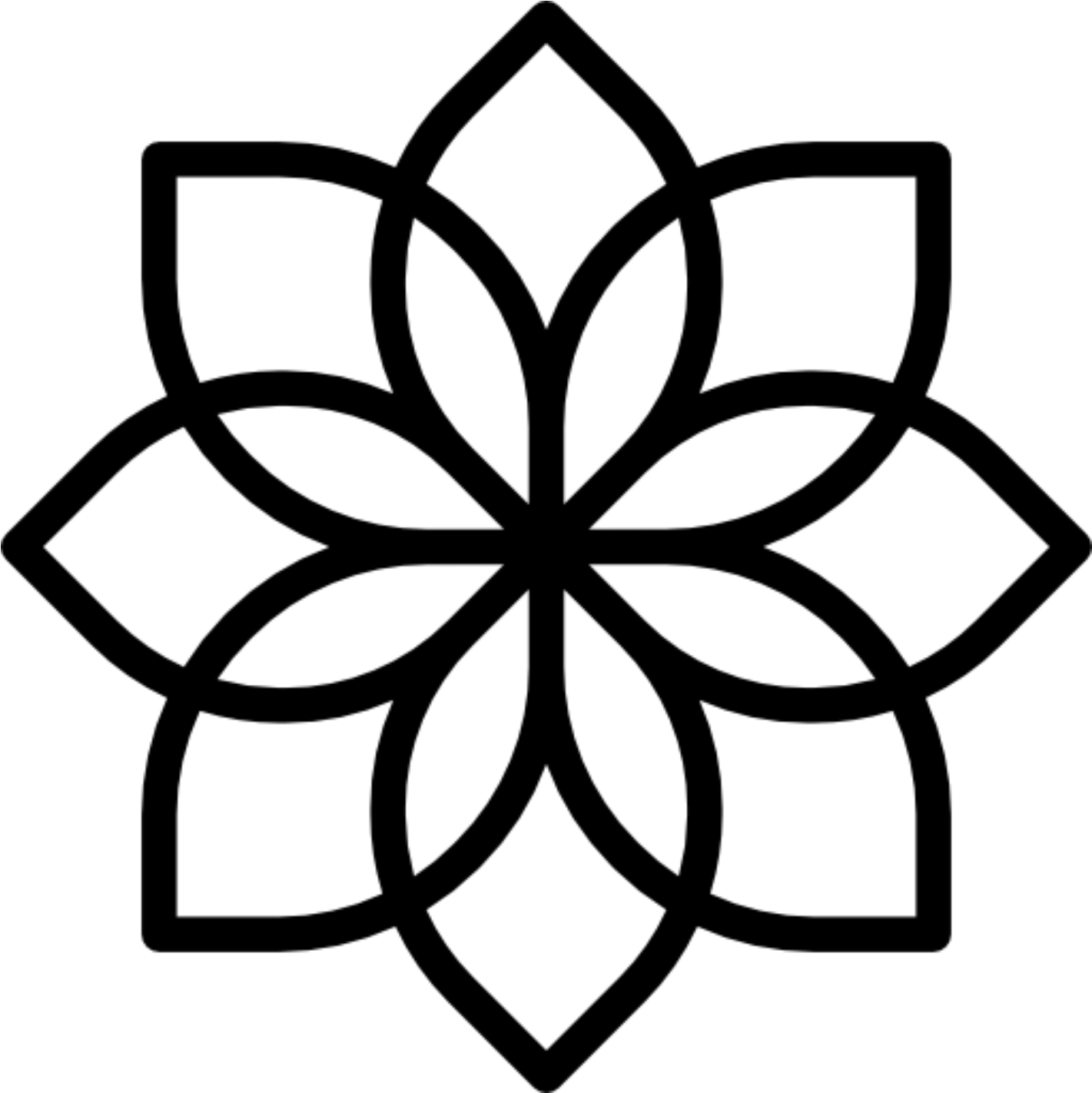


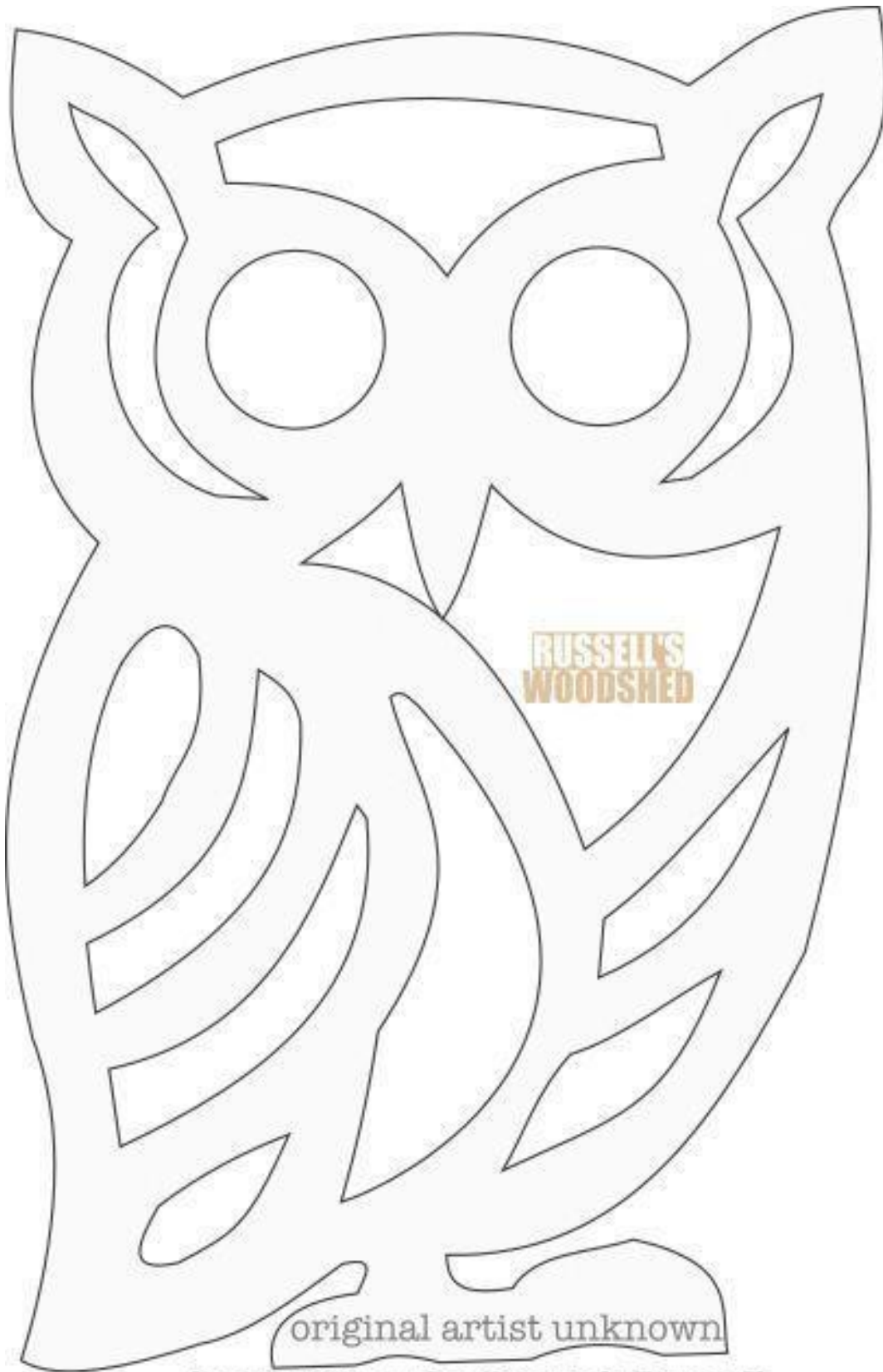
